WDJS (What Did Jesus Say?)

Monday

When Jesus heard about John, he withdrew in a boat to a deserted place by himself. When the crowds learned this, they followed him on foot from the cities. (Matthew 14.13) When Jesus heard that John the Baptist was beheaded, he withdrew in a quiet time of solitude. When bad things happen take time for quiet prayer.

Tuesday

But Jesus said to them, "There's no need to send them away. You give them something to eat." (Matthew 14.16) Have you felt overwhelmed with too much to do and not enough to do it? Don't give up; give it up to the Lord!

Wednesday

They replied, "We have nothing here except five loaves of bread and two fish." He said, "Bring them here to me." (Matthew 14.17-18) Don't belittle the little you have. With the Lord's help, enough is more than enough!

Thursday

Just then Jesus spoke to them, "Be encouraged! It's me. Don't be afraid." (Matthew 14.27) We may fear when we think we are all alone. Be encouraged, when we are with Jesus, we are never alone.

Friday

Saturday

Jesus immediately reached out and grabbed him, saying, "You man of weak faith! Why did you begin to have doubts?" (Matthew 14.31) Undoubtedly, we walk by faith. Doubtfully, we fall. Work on the former.
