WDJS (What Did Jesus Say?)

Monday

Learn this parable from the fig tree. After its branch becomes tender and it sprouts new leaves, you know that summer is near. (Matthew 24.32) Can you tell it is fall and soon will be winter? What signs are you watching for this time of year?

Tuesday

I assure you that this generation won't pass away until all these things happen. (Matthew 24.34) Jesus warns his followers about the end, and Matthew shares it with the readers who are remaining faithful while waiting for it to happen in their lifetimes.

Wednesday

Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will certainly not pass away. (Matthew 24.35) A lot has passed away in the past two thousand years, but Jesus' words still ring out loud and clear today. Which of the Word's words speak to you?

Thursday

But nobody knows when that day or hour will come, not the heavenly angels and not the Son. Only the Father knows. (Matthew 24.36) Nobody knows the day, but only that we are always to be watching and ready. Be ready to share Jesus with someone today.

Friday

Two women will be grinding at the mill. One will be taken and the other left. Therefore, stay alert! You don't know what day the Lord is coming. (Matthew 24.41-42) Here is a glimpse of what will happen. Some will be ready and some will not. Be ready.

Saturday

Therefore, you also should be prepared, because the Human One will come at a time you don't know. (Matthew 24.44) This year, Christmas may not come on Dec. 25th. Be ready for whenever it comes to you this year and celebrate it.
