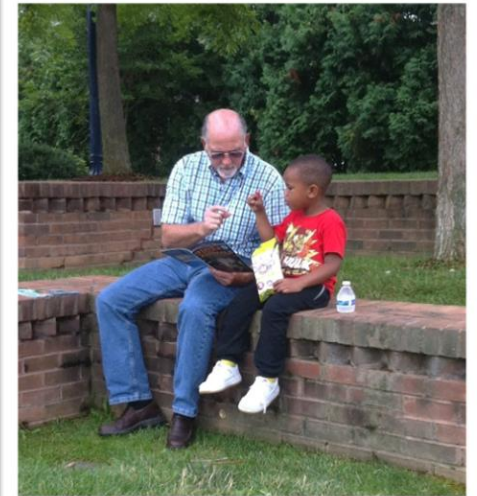

# Missions Ministry

## Ongoing Mission Projects

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Street & Hope – Soup Kitchen

This outreach ministry, located at Centennial UMC on 2<sup>nd</sup> Street in downtown Frederick, provides meals, clothing, recovery and housing support for the homeless and struggling. Our parish provides a meal at the Soup Kitchen on a Saturday evening, four to six times a year. We supply the food and volunteers to set up, serve and cleanup. ### Hope4Kids – Backpack Food Program

F Hope 4 Kids is a weekend food program that provides a package of food to children in our community. The needs of these children are identified by school staff. Every week a pack of food is sent home with the child to ensure they have a consistent source of nutrition on weekends and other days they do not receive school meals.
